Guy Ngan produced over forty public murals, sculptures, and friezes over the course of his career. However, knowledge of the fate of many of these works is patchy at best. Some have been lost, moved, or destroyed. Some may be hidden in boxes or concealed behind walls, while others undocumented and their authorship forgotten—may be hiding in plain sight.
